who can enter?

The competition is open to anyone associated with a non-professional under 18s football team who play on a football pitch in the UK.

what will the judges be looking for?

A panel consisting of a football pitch specialists and key turf journalists will judge the competition and will be looking for:

- A strong explanation as to why a particular pitch deserves a makeover.
- Good accompanying photographs of the pitch.
- A description about the team; how often they use the pitch and any special achievements.
- How the pitch condition has let them down.

ENTRY FORM

criteria of entry

- The nominee must put forward the name of a pitch in England upon which their team plays
- The Nominee must be associated with a non-professional under 18s football team (for example coach, parent, player)
- A condition of entry is that Briggs & Stratton can use details of the club in agreed publicity for the competition
- Entries must include information about the team, details of the pitch and accompanying images
- The pitch must be full size. The length of a pitch must be between 100 yards (90m) and 130 yards (120m) and the width not less than 50 yards (45m) and not more than 100 yards (90m).
- The pitch must be outdoors and made of grass
- Only one pitch can be nominated per team
- The nominee **must** have authorisation from the pitch owner (for example the parish council) to put forward the name of their pitch.

rules and conditions of entry

- Only individuals associated with an under 18 non-professional football team will be considered for the competition.
- The judges decision is final.
- Entries will only be considered if accompanied by an image.
- The organizers reserve the right to decline an entry without stating a reason.
- Only one nomination per team will be considered and this will be on the basis of which entry arrives first.
- All entrants must have prior consent from the pitch owner to nominate the pitch.
- The prize is non negotiable.
- The competition is open to UK residents only. Overseas players are not eligible.
- This competition is not open to employees or contractors of Briggs & Stratton and Paskett PR or any person directly or indirectly involved in the organisation or running of the competition, or their direct family members.
